ARROWHEAD HIGH SCHOOL REFERENDUM 2024



Following months of study and community input, the AHS school board has authorized two referendum questions for the November 5, 2024 ballot.

WHAT WILL BE ON THE NOVEMBER 5TH BALLOT?

QUESTION 1

OPERATING REFERENDUM

\$1.9 MILLION ANNUALLY (4 YEARS)

DESCRIPTION: \$1.9 million annually for four years beginning in 2025-26 to fund operational costs. The referendum will replace the school's current \$1.7 million operational referendum, which expires at the end of 2024-25.

Operational funding will be used to attract and retain staff in this competitive market, protect educational programming, keep pace with inflationary cost increases, and fund necessary maintenance and infrastructure needs.

QUESTION 2

NEW HIGH SCHOOL \$261.2 MILLION

DESCRIPTION: \$261.2 million to construct a new high school on the current AHS site. The approximately 555,000-square-foot high school will bring AHS under a single roof, including:

- Enhanced safety and security
- Elimination of inefficient, duplicate spaces
- New 8-lane competition pool also for community use
- 1,000-seat auditorium also for community use
- Indoor space for academic, co-curricular, and community programming
- Flexible classrooms and labs with advanced technology and collaboration spaces
- Minimal impact on learning activities during construction







WHY DO WE NEED TO GO TO REFERENDUM?

General school district revenue per pupil lags inflation by more than \$3,300 per year since 2009.

WHY PROPOSE THIS PLAN?





Avoids Significant Capital Maintenance Costs: By constructing a new high school, AHS will avoid an estimated \$143 million in capital maintenance to the current buildings.



Improves Safety & Security: A single building removes the ¼ mile, unsupervised walk for our students, minimizes the access locations to our school, and provides a single secure entrance for students, staff, and families.



Consolidates AHS Under One Roof: A single building will eliminate the inefficiencies of duplicated spaces, improve communication, improve access, and enhance our school community.

Invests In A Community Asset: The new high school will allow AHS to expand opportunities like aquatics, athletics, and the performing arts to the entire community.

Modernizes Teaching & Learning: Improving the learning environment and enhancing access to technology will help support academic, artistic, and athletic achievement.
