
The revised and reduced one building consolidation project lowers the cost of needed facilities improvements while investing in AHS students.

On April 1, 2025, voters will have the opportunity to consider a new solution to Arrowhead's facilities needs.

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The proposed referendum consolidates the AHS school buildings under one roof by renovating and expanding the North building. The revised and reduced plan lowers the cost of building and site improvements at a not-to- exceed project cost of \$136.2 million.

Estimated Tax Impact: \$1.02 per \$1,000 of property value.
